Did you know that....?

- **\$6,409,283.00** has been the net return to the Town of Brewster's General Fund from the Captains Golf Course (May '85 thru Dec. '09).
- ALL DEBT SERVICE has been and will be paid off by GOLF COURSE REVENUE.
- \$1,161,480.00 has been raised for Cape Cod charities at fund-raising events held at the Captains Golf Course (2002 thru 2009).
- In **2008** the \$2.2 million bond for the original Captains Golf Course was paid off.
- In 2014 the \$800,000 bond for improvement of the original irrigation system will be paid off.
- In 2015 the \$300,00 bond for bunker improvements will be paid off.

• In **2020** the \$9.87 million bond for the 1999 expansion will be paid off.
